The Wood County Board of Developmental Disabilities is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for its employees and the individuals enrolled in the program and services it provides. Such environment will be in compliance with applicable OSHA standards as set forth in Title 29 of the Department of Labor Standards and the Standards established by the Public Employment Risk Reduction Advisory Committee for Ohio and any other applicable federal, state, and local health and safety regulations.

In order to comply with the aforementioned standards, the Wood County Board of DD will establish a Health and Safety Committee which shall develop and provide policies, procedures and practices which shall recognize and protect employees and people served from health and safety hazards.

Information concerning communicable and infectious disease and any pandemic that would occur will be disseminated as needed and as confidentiality allows.

All employees will follow all established written procedures in regard to the health, safety, and protection of all people served and employees.

All Directors and Supervisors will annually review all health-related policies and procedures and develop systematic methods for sharing relevant health procedure with people served and parents/guardians.
