- The following definitions will apply:
- Communicable/Infectious Disease** - Capable of being transmitted from one person to another.
 - Bed Bugs** – Are not considered communicable or an infectious disease, individuals/employees should take proper universal precautions for public nuisance.
1. It shall be the policy of the Wood County Board of Developmental Disabilities to establish, maintain and to administer vouchers for the payment of inspection/treatment for bed bugs in employee’s homes.
 2. If an employee provides/coordinates services in an individual’s home that is contaminated with bed bugs, the WCBDD will cover the costs of an inspection and if necessary, treatment of the employee’s home.
 3. Employees must provide inspection/treatment invoice to the individual’s SSA to be entered in the voucher system. Employee must ensure that chosen vendor has a W-9 on file or is willing to submit a W-9.
