It is the policy of the Wood County Board of Developmental Disabilities to offer transportation services to its consumers in the Pre-School Program, the School Age Program, the Adult Services Program and the Special Olympics Program. Services offered are by the Wood County Board of Developmental Disabilities owned or leased vehicles including school buses, vans, cars and trucks. The Board offers transportation through the following:

- a) School Bus System,
- b) By staffing providing transportation to consumers who are enrolled in programs including but not limited to Adult Services; or
- c) The Shuttle System

Authorized passengers include family members, caregivers, all staff and volunteers involved in programming and individuals who are either being considered for enrollment or are enrolled in existing programs.

Any other use of Board vehicle must be approved under a separate agreement with the approval of the Superintendent or designee.
