- 1. In general, the number of eligible infant/toddlers per full-time primary service provider will not exceed twenty-five (25). This number may be affected by a number of variables including: 1) the extent and intensity of the child's needs; 2) the extent and intensity of family support needed: 3) location of services and supports, including travel time 4) the involvement of ancillary personnel and other agencies. 5) the availability of Board resources.
- 2. There may be periods of time when the number of children/families who need early intervention services cause the caseload of the fulltime primary service provider (s) to exceed twenty-five (25). As it is imperative that children and families receive service, a waiting list will not be maintained. However, if the caseload of the primary service provider (s) exceeds twenty-five (25) for a period of six (6) months, a committee will be formed to make recommendations for additional personnel.
