- 1. Supervision by a certified WCBDD lifeguard is required for all pool activities.
- 2. Entrance and exit permitted only through locker rooms, except in an emergency.
- 3. Everyone must rinse off before swimming.
- 4. Only swimsuits are permitted no cut-offs, t-shirts, or shorts.
- 5. No smoking, food, gum, or beverage is allowed in the pool or locker room area.
- 6. Absolutely no horseplay or unsafe actions are permitted. This includes running, pushing, or dunking.
- 7. Absolutely no headfirst entry.
- 8. No jumping on the movable floor and trailing ramp or into the whirlpool area.
- 9. Swimming pool users must obey the lifeguards at all times.
- 10. No breakable containers or metal objects that might be hazardous may be brought into the pool or locker room area.
- 11. Anyone with a contagious or infectious condition such as athlete's foot, ringworm, boils, or other skin infection is not permitted to use the pool and the lifequard(s) is/are authorized to remove individuals from the pool.
- 12. No flotation devices are allowed in the pool unless approved by lifeguard or pool supervisor.
- 13. Only authorized and trained personnel can operate the moveable floor, handi-move and whirlpool.
- 14. The lifeguard has complete authority of the pool. Users will be asked to leave for improper attire or conduct.
- 15. No visiting with guards on duty.
- 16. P.A. System and phone are for use in emergencies only.
- 17. All pool users must be able to safely manage their actions in the therapy pool or be accompanied in the water by an adult.
- 18. The lifeguard has the authority to determine who may use the pool.
- 19. Rules/Regulations will be posted or explained by pool personnel prior to pool use.
- 20. All facilities are alcohol and drug free environments. Therefore, at no time are alcohol or drugs permitted on the premises of Wood County Board of DD property.
