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| 1. To operate: Turn knob on south wall next to women's locker room to the right (clockwise) to turn it on. NOTE: It can be set to run continuously by turning the knob all the way to the left; or it can be set to run for up to 60 minutes by turning the knob to the left until the appropriate time length is selected. |
| 2. The lifeguard(s) on duty has the right to turn off the whirlpool if the foam is obstructing visibility in any way. |
| 3. The lifeguard will immediately clear all pools users from the pool if water clarity is hampered from whirlpool use (foam). |
| 4. The whirlpool will shut off immediately and will not be used again for that session. |
| 5. The lifeguard will not permit anyone to re-enter the pool until the pool bottom is completely visible (no foam). |

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
