PROCEDURE			
1. Integrated Pest Management is a process through which pest risk is minimized by the appropriate and prudent use of pesticides.			
2. The Health and Safety Coordinator is a Wood Lane School designated representative to communicate with a certified pest control			
licensed contractor, on the schools behalf, and supervise the contractor's service.			
Precision targeting treatments is essential in attaining the most efficient pest management.			
4. Monthly inspections will consist of examining the entire inside and outside of Wood Lane School. These inspections will be performed			
by an outside contractor. The contractor will document the findings and a copy will be filed at Wood Lane School and a copy will be			
retained by the Health and Safety Coordinator.			
5. As needed application of treatments, only after a pest infestation has been identified during an inspection.			
6. The contractor will notify the Health and Safety Coordinator before any treatment of any pesticide is conducted.			
7. No pesticide is to be applied in any room or area while in use or occupied by faculty, staff or students.			
8. A record of treatment form should be completed by the contractor whenever treatment is enacted to correct a pest problem.
