



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| 1. Radon levels will be tested at WLS beginning in the 2007-2008 school year. The test will be performed by an individual or company licensed by the ODH (Ohio Department of Health) |
| 2. If the radon levels are in the acceptable range, at or below 4.0 pCi/L, WLS will be tested for radon every five (5) years. |
| 3. If the test results are above the acceptable range WLS will develop a mitigation plan to reduce radon levels to an acceptable level. If installation of a mitigation system is necessary, WLS will employ an ODH licensed mitigation contractor to design and install a mitigation system and the building will be tested every two (2) years. |
| 4. The Health and Safety Coordinator will be responsible for coordinating testing and mitigation, as necessary. |
| 5. Upon completion of testing, WLS will report the test results to the Wood County Health Department. |
| 6. Records pertaining to testing and any mitigation will be kept on file in the Children's Services Administrative Supervisor's office and kept for a minimum of five years and then archived for another five years. |
